## Competitions

### COMPETITIONS

All competitions are to be played in one division only, unless otherwise stipulated. Winner to be the best nett score on the day. Handicap Manager to keep records. Players responsible for recording on Charts in clubhouse.

**CHAMPIONSHIPS** - To be played over three rounds of 18 holes. Six programmed Championship weeks beginning first week in June. Champion and runner-up are not eligible to win the nett trophy.

**NEAREST TO PIN** - Holes 4 & 18 for all players. Holes 6 & 10 for 40+ handicaps, second hit to the black, on the black. There only needs to be one player in this competition.

**SILVER SPOON** – To be played over four rounds with winners to play off for the trophy. Donated by M Woolford

**INTERNATIONAL BOWL** – best card of three stroke rounds, entries to Golf Australia, South Australia Women's Statewide Events.

**MONTHLY MEDAL** - To be played each month with the winners to play off for the medal in August. Putting competition played in conjunction with qualifying rounds – winner receives golf ball.

**YEARLY ECLECTIC** - To be played over the whole season (Club Competition Day cards only). Half of player's handicap at beginning of last stroke round of season to be used.

**BIRDIE ECLECTIC** – To be played in 2 divisions (0-30 and 31-54). Donated by V Seidel

**PAR ECLECTIC** - To be played in two divisions (0-30 and 31-54). Donated by S Tattingham

**LAUREL WREATH** - The first round to be played on a Club Competition Day. Each round is to be played to a time limit. Strokes must be given where applied if playing beyond the eighteenth hole. Runner-up trophy donated by J Pole.

**CHIPS OUTS - B Seymour Trophy** - A trophy will be given to the person who records the most chip-outs on a Club Competition Day for the season. If you smooth under the ball, it is not eligible for a chip out.

**CHIP OUTS on away courses** – H/Cap Manager to keep tally. Donated by M Woolford

**PUTTING COMPETITION – M Pole Trophy** - Best two out of three rounds.

## Australian Countback System

1. For 18 hole events the best score for the last 9 holes shall be used. If there is still a tie the last 6 holes, or if still a tie the last 3 holes. If still a tie then hole by hole from 18th.
2. For 27 hole events, if the 9 hole round is played last, the first 18 holes shall be used. If still tied then use method as in 1.
3. In Handicap events the relevant handicap or fraction thereof shall be applied.
4. Where a penalty under rule 1.3c(2) of the Rules of Golf is applied to a result, this penalty shall be ignored so far as the count-back is concerned.

**NOTE:** For a 9 hole event the best score for the last 6 holes shall be used, if there is still a tie the last 3 holes, if a tie persists, then hole by hole from the 9th.

## Weekly Competitions

**LONGEST DRIVE** competitions will be held each week in each grade on the same hole. The captain will draw the hole the week before at the Saturday night presentation.

**NEAREST TO PIN:** 4, 6, 10, 14 and 18.

**NEAREST TO PIN FOR 2:** 8, 11 and 16.
